

FEES

Apart from Early Years funding the school receives no funds from the Department of Children, Schools and Families or the Local Education Authority. Fund raising by the friends of the school is an ongoing necessity to keep the level of fees at a reasonable level.

SCHOOL FEES 2010/2011

A deposit of **£200** (school) is payable on acceptance of a place. This deposit is non-refundable in the event of cancellation and will be retained and offset against the final term's fees when your child leaves. A **full term's notice or payment in lieu** is required for withdrawal from the school.

- £1760.00 per term
- £440 per month
- Fees are paid a term in advance or by monthly direct debit.
- There is a 15% sibling discount for second and subsequent children.

NURSERY FEES 2010/2011

On acceptance of a place in nursery we request a **£35** registration fee. If parents book additional sessions over and above five we request an additional **£50** deposit which will be retained and offset against the additional fees when your child leaves. One month's notice is required for withdrawal from the nursery or changes in hours.

- Morning session 9.00am – 12.00pm
- Afternoon sessions 12.00pm-3.00pm
- The first 5 sessions are covered by the Early Years Funding
- Additional sessions £14.25 per session
- Optional additional lunch hour 12.00pm – 1.00pm £4.75 per day

- For bookings of 5 lunches per week or five additional sessions per week there is a 10% discount.
- There is no sibling discount for those attending the nursery.

- Children are eligible for free nursery funding if they turn three before the following dates:
September 1st – Autumn term
January 1st – Spring term
April 1st – Summer term
- The funding continues until the term after they turn five
- On full days parents can claim for 6 hours, equivalent of two consecutive three hour sessions.

We accept Childcare Vouchers, a scheme by which a working parent can take the first £55 per week or £243 per month of their salaries tax and NI free to help towards childcare costs over and above the EY free entitlement. For those parents in receipt of Working Family Tax credit and other benefits there is also additional help with childcare costs. Bursaries:

A very limited number of bursaries are available for low income families. Every bursary is means-tested and reviewed annually. For further information please contact the school office.
